WHITE FRESH, LIGHT, ZESTY - 175ml, 250ml, Bottle

- 1 Fernao Pires** £6 • £7.2 • £20.5
Cintilla, Península de Setúbal, Portugal 12%. An intense, fruity aroma and a creamy mouthfeel with a hint of peach and ginger.
- 2 Sauvignon Blanc** £6 • £7.5 • £21.5
Tierra Antica, Valle Central, Chile 12%. A clean and fruity wine with a fresh lemon and herbaceous character, refreshing and easy drinking.
- 3 Pinot Grigio** £6.4 • £8.2 • £23.5
Novità Veneto, Italy 12%. A vibrant tangy freshness with aromas of pear, grapefruit zest and a hint of spiciness.
- 4 Sauvignon Blanc** £7.3 • £9.4 • £27
'Tuatara Bay', Saint Clair Marlborough, NZ 12.5%. Aromas of passionfruit & blackcurrant are complemented by fresh notes of green leaf and a hint of flint.
- 5 Picpoul de Pinet 'Terroir'** £7.7 • £9.9 • £28.5
Gérard Bertrand Languedoc, France 13%. Rich with zesty citrus fruit and melon, floral notes and a fresh, green apple finish.
- 6 Gavi di Gavi** £8.5 • £11 • £32
Michele Chiarlo, Piedmont, Italy 12.5%. Floral and fruity showcasing appealing aromas of exotic fruits and white peach. Well structured and balanced on the palate.
- 7 Sancerre** £8.7 • £11.2 • £32.5
Domaine Gérard Millet, Loire, France 12.5%. Vibrant Sauvignon notes of grapefruit and lemon with good weight and a clean crisp finish.

WHITE - RICH, FRUITY, AROMATIC - 175ml, 250ml, Bottle

- 8 Chardonnay** £6.5 • £8.3 • £23.7
Domaine des Pourthié, Pays d'Oc, Languedoc, France 14%. A dry wine with an elegant hint of butteriness on the nose, refreshing green fruits combined with creaminess on the palate and a lively finish.
- 9 Vermentino** £6.8 • £8.70 • £25
San Marzano 'Timo', Puglia, Italy 12%. Delicate white floral aromas combine with notes of thyme and rosemary in this elegant, refreshing and mineral wine.
- 10 Albariño 'Coral do Mar'** £7.5 • £9.7 • £28.5
Pazo do Mar, Galicia, Spain 13%. Fresh flavours of orange peel, pineapple and white flowers with a rich mouthfeel.
- 11 Bachus 'Cobble Hill'** £8 • £10.4 • £30
Perowne Wines 2019, North Norfolk 12%. Direct hit of tangy grapefruit with green grassy notes and that distinctive elderflower character.
- 12 Pinot Gris** £8.3 • £10.7 • £31
Dopff Au Moulin, Alsace, France 13.5%. This is a dry, racy wine with linear freshness and beautiful texture with white stone fruits leading to a long, harmonious finish.
- 13 Chardonnay** £9.3 • £12 • £35
Domaine de l'Aigle, Gerard Bertrand, Languedoc, France 14%. A floral and aromatic Chardonnay with white peach flavours complemented by nutty, toasty tones and a lovely creamy texture. A great Burgundy at Languedoc prices.
- 14 Riesling** £35
Schloss Johannisberg, Riesling Feinherb 'Yellow Seal', Rheingau, Germany 12%. A fragrant, fruity bouquet of grapefruit, apple and lychee with hints of fresh grass characterise this fine, off dry Riesling. Beautifully balanced, with a full bodied texture and a creamy finish. Classic and vibrant German Riesling.

ROSÉ - 175ml, 250ml, Bottle

- 15 Zinfandel Blush** £5.9 • £7.5 • £21.5
Misty Peak, California, USA 10.5%. Watermelon, strawberry and white nectarine, with a silky texture and a soft finish.
- 16 Syrah Grenache Rosé** £6 • £7.7 • £22
'Le Campuget', Ch de Campuget, France 13%. It shows delicious crunchy red fruit aromas with a hint of minerality; the palate is lively, full of fresh fruits and balanced by a refreshing acidity.
- 17 Cote de Provence Rosé** £6.9 • £8.9 • £25.5
Château de l'Aumérade, Côtes de Provence, France 13%. Pale salmon in colour, this is the quintessential Provence rosé. A refreshingly fruity bouquet leads to delicate white spice and mineral flavours on the palate and an elegant finish.
- 18 'Rosé Hampton Water'** £8.5 • £11 • £32
Gérard Bertrand, Languedoc, France 13%. A nicely crafted rose, with a hint of creamy richness lining the strawberry, melon and white cherry flavours. A dash of minerality imparts depth through the long, mouthwatering finish. A real crowd-pleaser made from Grenache, Cinsault, Mourvedre and Syrah. 90 Points - Wine Spectator.





RED WINES

MELLOW & EASY DRINKING - 175ml, 250ml, Bottle

19 Castelao £5.7 • £7.2 • £20.5
Cintila, Península de Setúbal, Portugal 12.5%. A rich, red cherry and vanilla wine, with soft tannins and an easy-drinking finish.

20 Merlot, Tierra Antica £5.9 • £7.5 • £21.5
Valle Central, Chile 13%. Red and black fruit aromas of cherries and blackberries are interwoven with a subtle, spicy bay leaf character.

21 Rioja Crianza £6.8 • £8.7 • £25
Hugonell, Rioja, Spain 13.5%. A classic and meaty Rioja blend of rich strawberry fruit, beautifully integrated vanilla and savoury characters.

22 Pinot Noir £7.5 • £9.7 • £28
Saint Clair, Marlborough, New Zealand 13.5%. Ripe red fruits, plums and strawberries with a subtle touch of smokiness and a fresh, savoury finish.

23 Valpolicella £7.5 • £9.7 • £28
Gérard DOC Rio Albo, Veneto, Italy 12.5%. Concentrated aromas of red fruits, ripe blackberry and deep cherry flavours, with floral notes and a hint of spice. Supple on the palate with a velvety texture.

24 Pinot Noir £9 • £11.7 • £34
Domaine de l'Aigle, Gerard Bertrand, Languedoc, France 14.5%. An aromatic Pinot Noir with bright notes of raspberry and cranberry accompanied by spicy top notes. Elegant and smooth on the palate, with exceptional structure and a long, silky finish.

25 Ribera Del Duero £9 • £11.7 • £34
Bodegas Resalte de Peñafiel, 2014, Ribera del Duero, Spain 14.5%. A complex wine full of finesse, with fruity notes of blackberry, cherry and liquorice enveloped in exquisitely integrated oak. A full bodied palate with ripe tannins finishes with textured, long lasting depth. 91 Points, Wine Advocate. 91 Points, Wine Spectator.

BOLD, INTENSE & COMPLEX - 175ml, 250ml, Bottle

26 Garnacha Syrah £6.5 • £8.3 • £23.7
Uclés, Dominio de Fontana, Central Castile, Spain 14.5%. A rich, juicy red showing expressive herbal and fruity notes from the Garnacha and pepper spice from the Syrah. A delicate wine with a good texture and a persistent, fruit forward finish.

27 Malbec 'Alto Molino' £6.9 • £8.9 • £25.5
Piattelli Vineyards, Salta, Argentina 14.5%. Heady, rich mix of dark and brambly fruits combined with dark chocolate.

28 Côtes du Rhône £7.4 • £9.5 • £27.5
Domaine de la Solitude, Rhône, France 14%. An enticing nose of concentrated, ripe red berry fruits, enhanced by subtle notes of black pepper and spice.

29 Syrah 'La Sommelière' £8.5 • £11 • £32
Château de Campuget, 2016, Rhône, France 13.5%. Concentrated with ripe Syrah notes of chocolate and spice complemented by toasty oak.

30 Saint-Émilion Grand Cru £8.3 • £10.7 • £34.5
Château Cruzeau 2015, Bordeaux, France 14.5%. A classically styled wine with earthy and chocolate notes complemented by a rich and opulent texture.

31 Barolo £34.5
Domaine San Silvestro 'Patres', Piedmont, Italy 14.5%. A stylish Barolo, with expressive aromas of dried fruit, roses and tar. The deep fruits are layered with minerality on the smooth and mouth-filling palate and sweet tannins weave through to a very long, elegant finish.

32 Margaux £43.5
Initial de Desmirail, Margaux, Bordeaux, France 12%. An elegant and silky Margaux with a purity of black fruits complemented by subtle toasted notes and cedar. Elegant with silky tannins, it is perfectly balanced through to a lingering finish.

33 Chateau L'Hospitalet £44
Grand Vin Rouge, Gerard Bertrand, 2019, Languedoc, France 15.5%. Balanced and elegantly structured palate reveals silky tannins that highlight the opulent fruit to a long finish.
